

Well Seasoned Welcome Wreath Information

Dimensional leaves and berries burst with color and beauty. There are several fabulous techniques that will be perfected in this hands-on class. A revolutionary way of placing fabric on odd angles, while paper piecing, and having the fabric fold back perfectly covering. One quarter of the quilt top will be finished in class with detailed instructions on how to finish your quilt top. The pattern comes with a Christmas and Spring variations and additional instructions for completing those quilts is included. **Kit:\$25.00** includes the pattern and everything needed to finish the quilt except the batting and backing. **Basic Class Supplies:**

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Thread to match
- 80/12 or 90/14 needles for paper piecing
- Scissor that you don't mind cutting paper
- Cutting mat, ruler and rotary cutter

To bring your own fabrics: If bringing your own fabrics, you will need to buy the pattern for \$5.50

- Leaves 1/3 yard
- Large Border 1/3 yard
- Background 1/2 yard
- Leaves 1/3 yard
- Divide this by the number of colors your would like, keeping in mind the leaves need at least a 2 1/2" width.
- Berries 1/4 yard
- Divide this by the number of colors you would like, keeping in mind each berry requires at least a 2" width.
- Stem 1/4 yard
- To get the needed 10" length of bias, you will need at least 1/4 yard.
- Batting 26" x 26"
- Binding 1/4 yard
- Stuffing for berries
- Embroider Floss
